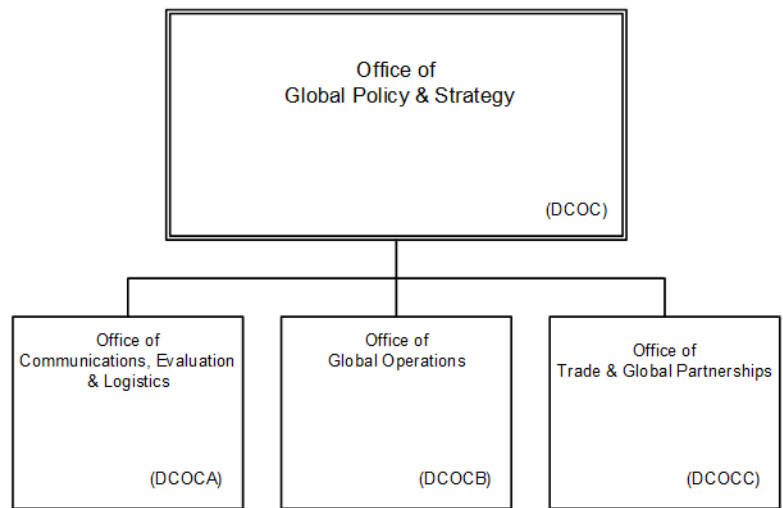
1. Office of Global Policy and Strategy (DCOC).

- A. Advises and assists the Commissioner, the Deputy Commissioners, and other key Food and Drug Administration (FDA) officials on international matters.
- B. Provides executive oversight, strategic leadership, and policy direction on FDA's global engagements, including information sharing, institutional linkages, international standards development, trade relations, multilateral organization relationships, initiatives and efforts with ministries of health, national regulatory authorities, foundations, private-sector and civil-society stakeholders, public-private partnerships, and FDA foreign office activities.
- C. Serves as the primary FDA liaison with other U.S. Government components involved in national security and foreign affairs, and international issues, international multinational organizations and foreign governments (including Washington, DC embassies) for policy formulation and execution affecting FDA regulated products.
- D. Serves as the primary FDA liaison for foreign counterpart regulatory agencies, multi- and plurilateral organizations, foreign embassies, and foreign officials for interactions and international activities affecting FDA regulated products.
- E. Provides the Commissioner, the Deputy Commissioners, the Associate Commissioners, and other key FDA officials with analysis and insight on global and cross-cutting regulatory, economic, political, and societal factors affecting FDA regulated goods.

2. Authority and Effective Date.

The functional statements for the Office of Global Policy and Strategy were approved by the Commissioner of Food and Drugs, and effective on September 30, 2022.
