The VisAbilityTM Micro Insert is indicated for bilateral scleral implantation to improve unaided near vision in phakic, presbyopic patients between the ages of 45 and 60 years of age, who have a manifest spherical equivalent between -0.75 D and +0.50 D with less than or equal to 1.00 D of refractive cylinder in both eyes, and require a minimum near correction of at least +1.25 D reading add.
