FDA oversees the safety of more than **\$2.7 trillion** worth of food, tobacco, and medical products.

FDA-regulated products account for about **20 cents of every dollar** spent by U.S. consumers.



FDA regulates about **78%** of the U.S. food supply; except meat, poultry, and some egg products.

About 57% of fresh fruit, 34% of vegetables, and 91% of seafood consumption by volume are imports.



There are about **621** FDA-licensed biologics products.

About 84% of biologics sales are imports.



FDA oversees over **100,000** tobacco products, not including ENDS.

About 3% of tobacco product sales are imports.



There are over **20,000** prescription drug products approved for marketing.

About 78% of active pharmaceutical ingredient manufacturers are located outside of the U.S.



FDA oversees over **6,700** different medical device products.

About 44% of medical devices used in this country are imports.



There are about **1,600** FDA-approved animal drug products.

About 5% of animal product sales are imports.



FDA regulations cover about:

- 35,000 produce farms
- 10,500 vending machine operators
- 300,000 restaurant food establishments



- FDA products are manufactured or handled at nearly 275,000 registered facilities, more than half of which are outside the U.S.
- FDA-regulated products account for 15% of U.S. imports and 15% of exports.

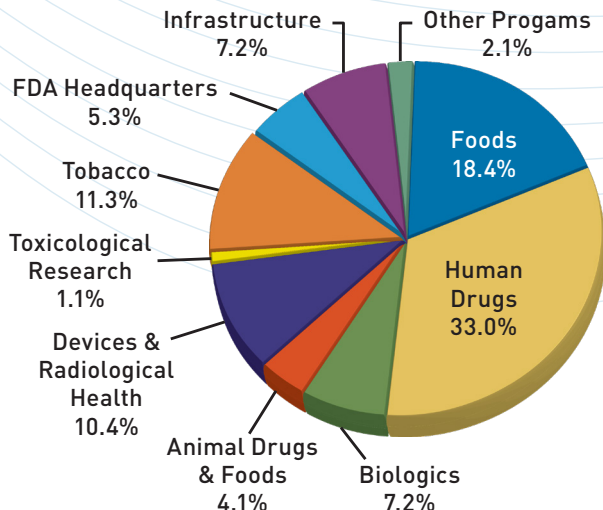

FY 2021 FDA Budget by Program (Total = \$6.1 billion)



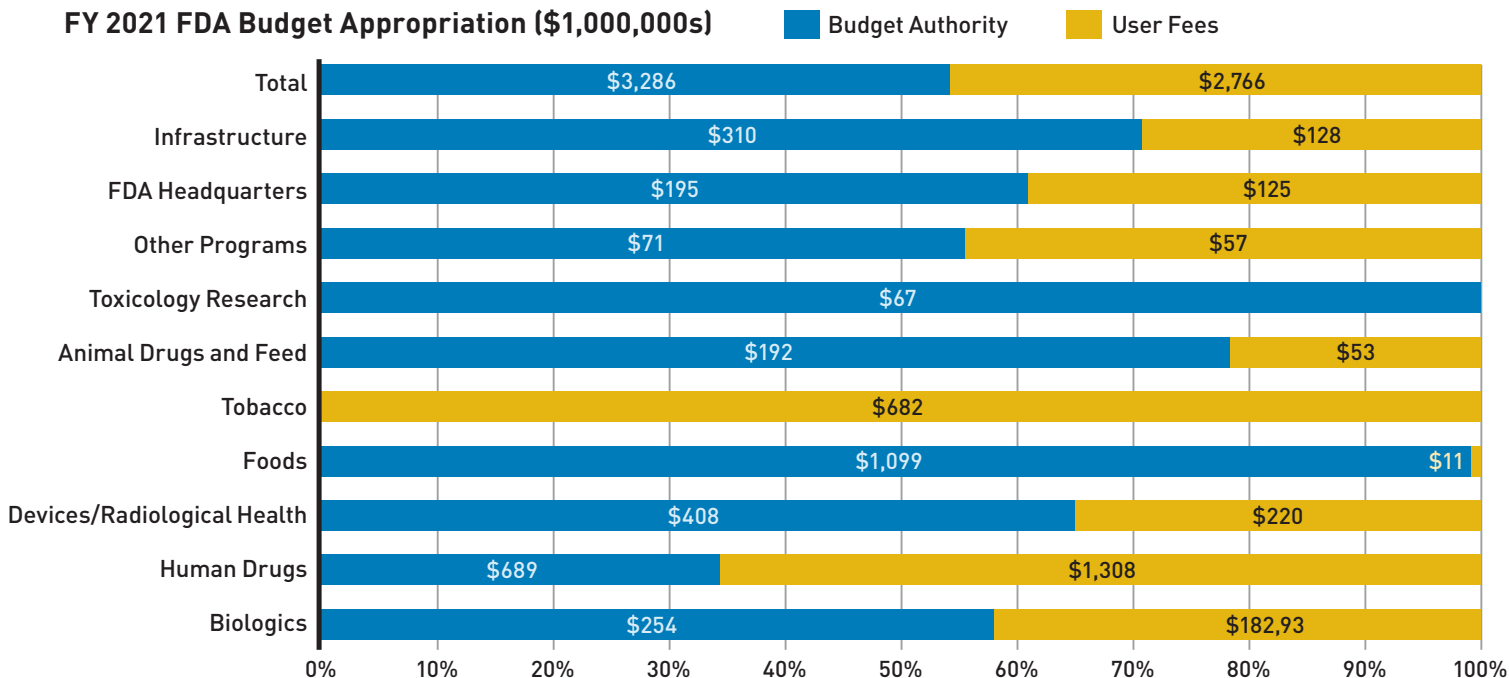
FDA's budget for Fiscal Year 2021 is:

- approximately \$6.1 billion.
- provided by federal budget authorization (54%, or \$3.3 billion) and user industry fees (46%, or \$2.8 billion).
- equivalent to \$10.01 per American per year and includes 18,062 full time equivalents (FTEs).

The share of a program's funding paid by industry user fees varies from about 1% for Foods to 100% of Tobacco regulatory activities.

Notes: Infrastructure includes rent, rent related activities, FDA buildings and facilities, and White Oak consolidation. Other programs include Export Certification and Color Certification Fund.

FDA, an agency within the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, protects public health by regulating human and veterinary drugs, vaccines and other biological products, medical devices, our nation's food supply, cosmetics, dietary supplements, electronic radiation emitting products, and tobacco products. FDA at a Glance is published annually by FDA's Office of Economics and Analysis (OEA), within the Office of Policy, Legislation, and International Affairs, Office of the Commissioner. OEA's mission is to provide public health, economic, and strategic analysis and evaluation to inform FDA's policy and rulemaking decisions.
