






Clinical Trials Have Not Always Represented US Population






More than half of Pfizer trials achieved census levels for Black/African American participants White participants and Hispanic or Latino participants



Patient advocacy organization to recruit a racially diverse patients experienced pulmonary embolism (PE)

Patients survey experience with PE and their feelings towards clinical trial participation



Patient Advisory Panel

Select group of patients (~20) to participate in a live moderated patient advisory panel to provide specific feedback on BREATHE clinical trial design

Feedback from patient advisors to improve the design and conduct

Diversity in Research Initiative

In November 2021, Abbott launched our "Diversity in Research" initiative to develop a more inclusive clinical trial ecosystem in the U.S.




Convening patient advocates, industry experts, trialists and thought leaders to develop and publish an open-source perspective for industry to highlight opportunities to diversify trials
