



Related Respiratory Diagnosis:

Severe emphysema (x years)

Respiratory Home Use Devices:

Pulse Oximeter (x years)

Pulse Oximeter Use:

Sporadically checks oxygen saturation levels

Primary concern with Pulse Oximeter:

Not certain about the accuracy of readings

Related Respiratory Diagnoses:

- Laryngeal/pharyngeal insufficiency
- Dysphagia
- Paralysis of the left vocal cord
- Chronic respiratory impairment
- Recurrent episodes of pneumonia

Respiratory Home Use Devices:

- Pulse Oximeter (lifetime)
- Tracheostomy tube

Pulse Oximeter Use:

- Continual monitoring of daughter's oxygen levels during sleeps
- Monitors for dislodgement/occlusion of the trach, vomiting and choking
