The purpose of this letter is to confirm that Solvay Specialty Polymers USA LLC. (“Company”) has, as of 7/1/2022, voluntarily ceased introduction and delivery into interstate commerce the products identified by Food Contact Notification (FCN) Nos. 187, 195, 398, 416, 538, and 962 for any use in food-contact applications in the United States and subject to the jurisdiction of the United States Food and Drug Administration (FDA). The Company pledges that it will not market these products for food contact applications in the United States in the future. Please note that products identified by the above listed FCNs were placed on the market by the Company prior to 7/1/2022, as such are no longer in the possession and control of the Company, and may remain on the market until stocks are consumed.

The Company acknowledges that FDA may, in its discretion, amend the Inventory of Effective Food Contact Notifications with respect to the FCNs listed above to reflect the commitments of this letter.

The undersigned Company representative is authorized to make these representations and commitments on behalf of the Company. This letter and the representations and commitments contained herein are and will continue to be binding on the Company and its successors and assignees with respect to products which are identified by the FCNs listed above.
