
1. Office of Nutrition and Food Labeling (DCRLA).

- A. Directs planning, policy development, and management of food and nutrition labeling of conventional foods.
- B. Develops policy, regulations, guidance, and advisory opinions for matters within the scope of the responsibility of the Office.
- C. Provides expert advice to leadership, other key officials, and directs major Food and Drug Administration (FDA) nutrition and food labeling initiatives as well as provides expertise in the area of nutrition and food labeling to federal and state partners, and international bodies.
- D. Provides food subject matter expertise, collaborates and consults on associated educational initiatives related to matters within the responsibility of the Office.

2. Authority and Effective Date.

The functional statements for the Office of Nutrition and Food Labeling were approved by the Secretary of Health and Human Services on March 5, 2024, and effective on May 13, 2024.
