POVERTY RURAL ACCESS TO CARE

#### WHY IT MATTERS

Patients with annual household incomes below \$50,000 were 32% less likely to participate in clinical trials compared to those with higher incomes

■Clinical trials often provide access to cutting-edge therapies, lower participation rates among low-income individuals may further exacerbate health inequalities2

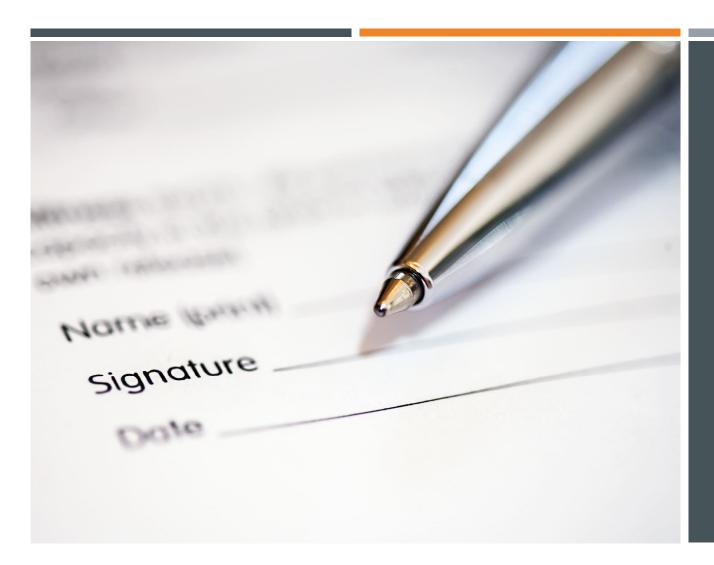






## TRULY PERSONALIZED INFORMED CONSENT
