Re: GRAS Notice AGRN 66 - Condensed Algal Residue Solubles

Dear Mr. Lewis:

The Food and Drug Administration's (FDA) Center for Veterinary Medicine (CVM) refers to a generally recognized as safe (GRAS) notice, dated March 11, 2024, submitted on behalf of DSM Nutritional Products, LLC (the notifier). The subject of the notice is condensed algal residue solubles derived from fermentation of microalgae *Schizochytrium* sp. as a source of protein, carbohydrates, minerals, and fat in beef cattle diets at 5% of dry matter intake in the diet. The submission informs us of the notifier's conclusion that the subject of the submission is GRAS through scientific procedures. The notice was filed on April 15, 2024, and designated as animal GRAS notice number (AGRN) 66. In an October 23, 2024 email to you, CVM informed the notifier of questions regarding their conclusion. Specifically, CVM has questions related to the adequacy of the human food safety assessment that was presented to reach a conclusion of safety.

CVM is granting your request dated November 5, 2024 to cease evaluation of the AGRN 66.
