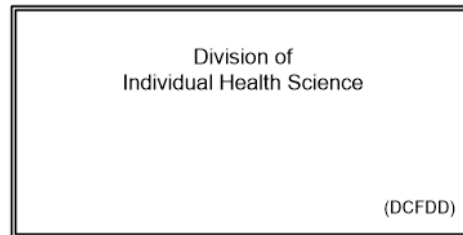
**1. Division of Individual Health Science (DCFDD).**

- A. Provides scientific expertise related to regulated tobacco products addictiveness (including clinical pharmacology and behavioral pharmacology), user behavior and clinical impact.
- B. Develops and implements policies and procedures governing clinical and behavioral science aspects of premarket review of reports of substantially equivalent (SE) tobacco products, exemptions from SE, applications for new tobacco products, and modified risk tobacco products and product standards developed to reduce the addictiveness of tobacco products.

**2. Authority and Effective Date.**

The functional statements for the Division of Individual Health Science were approved by the Secretary of Health and Human Services and effective on December 14, 2018.
