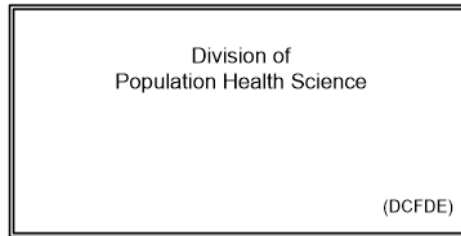
1. Division of Population Health Science (DCFDE).

- A. Provides scientific expertise related to tobacco epidemiology, user and non-user perception, and statistical evaluation.
- B. Develops and implements policies and procedures governing population science aspects of premarket review of reports of substantially equivalent (SE) tobacco products, exemptions from SE, applications for new tobacco products, and modified risk tobacco products and product standards developed to reduce the attractiveness of tobacco products, especially to youth.

2. Authority and Effective Date.

The functional statements for the Division of Population Health Science were approved by the Secretary of Health and Human Services and effective on December 14, 2018.
