1. Division of Quality Management Systems (DCDMDD).

- A. Ensures that all generic drug review and decision-making activities are well documented and follow a clearly defined, rigorous scientific and regulatory review process.
- B. Develops, implements, and supports procedures for continuous process improvement to enhance the efficiency of Office of Generic Drugs.
- C. Tracks all review activities and delivers non-biased data for monitoring and analyzing work progress, deliverables, process improvement, and resource allocation.
- D. Monitors, documents and supports the development of employees through appropriate skill and knowledge-based training. Ensures that employees are properly equipped for and matched to the type of work for which they are responsible.

2. Authority and Effective Date.
